Observing Through the 30" Challenger Telescope

This is a GREAT way to meet other amateur astronomers and talk to members of other astronomy clubs.

POTLUCK: Begins at about 4 PM. FPOA will be holding board member elections from 3 PM on. There will be various games throughout the afternoon. If you have a water pistol or supersoaker, bring it for the sixth annual Douse-Off!
